

From Boys to Men

- What it means to be <u>male</u> can simply be biological, but what it means to be a <u>man</u> is something more!
- Male domination is a personal moral failure, not a teaching in the Bible.
- The first battle of the sexes was a battle with God over roles and responsibilities!

Manhood: One who courageously accepts responsibility!

• Men accept responsibility; boys blame.

Three Core Responsibilities of Manhood:

I. There is a will to obey.

Genesis 2:15—17 (ESV)

The Lord God took the man and put him in the garden of Eden to work it and keep it. ¹⁶ And the Lord God commanded the man, saying, "You may surely eat of every tree of the garden, ¹⁷ but of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for in the day that you eat of it you shall surely die."

Genesis 3:1—12 (ESV)

Genesis 3:16—19 (ESV)

- Adam's <u>refusal</u> to obey the will of God brought on the battle of the sexes. (Luke 22:41-42)
- Manhood accepts the responsibility to obey God's will over his desires. (John 4:34)
- Men stand in the shadow of Christ; boys stand in the shadow of Adam.

II. There is a work to do.

- 1. The first work a man does is that of image bearing! (Genesis 1:26-27)
 - Men are image bearers; boys are glory thieves.
- 2. A man must find his role in <u>kingdom</u> advancement! (1 Corinthians 15:58; John 17:4)
 - Men invest their lives; boys spend their lives.
- 3. A man exceeds expectations in his <u>professional</u> life! (Colossians 3:23)
 - Men work; boys are lazy. (John 17:4)

III. There is a woman to love and care for. (Ephesians 5:25-27)

 Men serve, sacrifice for, and <u>protect</u> the woman in their lives; boys use women for their <u>own</u> pleasure and comfort.
