



## Infinite: A God of No Limits

### I. God is infinite: A God of no limits

- God is infinite in power, time, and place!

### II. Unpacking the omnipresence of God

Psalms 139:7–10 (ESV)

*Where shall I go from your Spirit? Or where shall I flee from your presence? <sup>8</sup> If I ascend to heaven, you are there! If I make my bed in Sheol, you are there! <sup>9</sup> If I take the wings of the morning and dwell in the uttermost parts of the sea, <sup>10</sup> even there your hand shall lead me, and your right hand shall hold me.*

### I. God is becoming God enough when we realize God is perfectly present!

- Our lack of intimacy with each other comes from our lack of intimacy with God.
- God is infinite and personal!

### 2. God is becoming God enough when we realize we are never alone!

Romans 8:38-39 (NIV)

*For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, <sup>39</sup> neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.*

- God's pledge to us is His presence!

John 16:7 (NIV)

*But very truly I tell you, it is for your good that I am going away. Unless I go away, the Advocate will not come to you; but if I go, I will send him to you.*

- God is near no matter how we feel!
- God is already present in our future!

### 3. God is becoming God enough when His presence overcomes our questions!

Psalms 23

*The Lord is my shepherd, I lack nothing. <sup>2</sup> He makes me lie down in green pastures, he leads me beside quiet waters, <sup>3</sup> he refreshes my soul. He guides me along the right paths for his name's sake. <sup>4</sup> Even though I walk through the darkest valley, I will fear no evil, for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me. <sup>5</sup> You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies. You anoint my head with oil; my cup overflows. <sup>6</sup> Surely your goodness and love will follow me all the days of my life, and I will dwell in the house of the Lord forever.*

- God may not answer the "why" but He will reveal the "Who"!  
(Job 42:5-6)

### 4. God's presence means nothing goes unnoticed!

- How mindful we are of God's nearness has a direct impact on how we live!

Jeremiah 23:23-24 (NIV)

*"Am I only a God nearby," declares the Lord, "and not a God far away?" <sup>24</sup> Who can hide in secret places so that I cannot see them?" declares the Lord. "Do not I fill heaven and earth?" declares the Lord.*

- God's presence leads us to greater levels of repentance and a deeper understanding of His grace.
