## Gossip: The Secret Destroyer

Proverbs 18:21 (ESV)

Death and life are in the power of the tongue, and those who love it will eat its fruits.

I. USS Gossip:

I. Gossip destroys our walk with God.

## Proverbs 6:16-19 (NIV)

There are six things the Lord hates, seven that are detestable to him: <sup>17</sup> haughty eyes, a lying tongue, hands that shed innocent blood, <sup>18</sup> a heart that devises wicked schemes, feet that are quick to rush into evil, <sup>19</sup> a false witness who pours out lies and a person who stirs up conflict in the community.

- Gossip demonstrates a total disregard for God's command to <u>love</u> one another. (John 13:35)
- Gossip feeds our <u>flesh</u>. (Proverbs 26:22)
- The root of gossip is pride. (James 4:6b)
- 2. Gossip destroys trust. (Proverbs 16:28; Proverbs 25:9-10)

- 3. Gossip destroys testimonies. (Genesis 9:18-28)
- Gossip is making a private matter public. (Romans 4:7-8)

Gossip is uncovering something that God has covered.

II. Battle Plan to Destroy Gossip:

- I. Develop a deep conviction about gossip! (Romans 1:28-31)
- 2. Talk <u>less</u>.

Proverbs 10:19 (NASB)

When there are many words, transgression is unavoidable, But he who restrains his lips is wise.

## 3. Refuse to listen to gossip.

Proverbs 17:4 (NLT) Wrongdoers eagerly listen to gossip; liars pay close attention to slander.

- Without an audience gossip dies.
- 4. Talk to the person not about the person.

Proverbs 25:9–10 (ESV)

Argue your case with your neighbor himself, and do not reveal another's secret, <sup>10</sup> lest he who hears you bring shame upon you, and your ill repute have no end.
