New Vision Worship Guide

You are invited to worship with us, in person! Church looks a little different as we resume meeting at our campuses, but we are working hard to ensure a safe worship experience for your family. Below, you'll learn what to expect as you join us for worship.

1. ARRIVAL + PARKING

When you arrive, our welcome team will direct you to a parking space to maintain social distancing. Team members will be wearing masks and will be available to guide you throughout your experience. Additional volunteers will be available at the Resource Stations located outside the entrance with hand sanitizer, masks, gloves, and at-risk bracelets. These bracelets are available for anyone who wants to indicate they are part of the at-risk population.

THINGS TO NOTE:

- Shuttle Buses will not be available so please make plans to park on campus. (Battlefield Campus only)
- Preschool Entrance will be closed.

2. ENTRANCE + SEATING

To help maintain social distancing we are asking everyone visiting the Battlefield Campus to enter through the North & South Atrium Entrances, and anyone visiting the Buchanan Campus to enter through the East & West Atrium Doors. Both worship centers are cleaned in-between services. Be on the look out for the Atrium doors to open or for the volunteers holding signs that say "Come on In!" Volunteers will direct each family to their designated worship area and guide you to a seat. Thank you in advance for your flexibility with seating.

Battlefield Campus - Once the Worship Center is filled, seating will proceed to The Chapel. Families with children will be guided to the Children's Building for a Family-Friendly Worship Experience.

3. DISMISSAL

Once service is finished, you will be dismissed by rows and sections to the most convenient door. As much as we'd all love to stay and socialize, in the interest of safety, please continue moving until you reach your car to help give us time to clean before the next service begins.

4. FACE MASKS

We recommend you bring a mask for each member of your family. If you forget, we will provide one for you at the Resource Station. We are following the CDC guidelines and are strongly encouraging all guests to wear a mask while attending worship services. We ask that masks be worn at all times out of love and concern for others in our church and in our community.

5. SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

We will be making the building as safe as possible in accordance with the guidance issued by the Governor's Office of Faith-Based & Community Initiatives:

- Staff and volunteers will be wearing masks and will be screened before service begins.
- Every chair will be sanitized prior to and between each worship service in accordance with CDC guidelines.
- We will have hand sanitizer stations available around both campuses.
- Greeters will give a friendly smile or wave rather than a handshake to help keep you experience contactless.
- No handouts of any kind will be distributed, but you can access Sermon Notes through the Bible app. Simply open the app, click the "More" tab, then "Events," and there you'll find New Vision.
- Tithes may be dropped off in the secure boxes at each exit or submitted online. The offering plate will not be passed.
- No coffee will be provided.
- We encourage all attendees over the age of 65 or those who have a compromised immune system to worship with us online.

6. SELF-SCREENING

Before coming to worship, we kindly ask that you self-screen your family, including taking temperatures. If you have had any of the following symptoms this week, please worship with us online:

- Fever Over 100.4
- Cough or Sore Throat
- Shortness of Breath
- Contact with anyone confirmed to have COVID-19 (in the past 14 days)
